Ms. Muniz,

Thank you for submitting an application to the Central Florida CoC under the FY2019 Continuum of Care RFP. Unfortunately your application was not selected to be included in the federal submission to HUD.

Threshold items that prevented your application from consideration included:

- Your organization did not participate in the required information session for potential new applicants. This session, announced at CoC meetings, on the CoC website, and in several email blasts, was held on three different dates.
- Your organization submitted no audit.
- Your organization was not able to provide documentation of active participation in an HMIS comparable system, including an APR. Without this data the CoC is not able to fully evaluate the project's ability to assist the CoC to improve its system performance measures.

We recognize that these issues are primarily associated with how new your organization is in the Central Florida region and that they do not reflect on the quality of your work or your mission.

Please also know that there was not adequate funding to support all submitted applications. The CoC had \$528,048 in funding to award to new projects, but received 6 new project applications totaling \$970,462 in requests.
