March 29 - National Vietnam Veterans Day

The commemoration honors and thanks all Ú.S. veterans who served on active duty from November 1, 1955 to May 15, 1975, regardless of location. There are 6.4 million Vietnam and era veterans, 58,320 paid the ultimate sacrifice, and there are still nearly 1,600 missing in action. March 29 was chosen because that was the day in 1973 when the last 2,500 U.S. troops were withdrawn from South Vietnam, and the last of American POWs held in North Vietnam arrived back home. Upon returning to the United States, many were mistreated and forgotten. Some of the Vietnam veterans went into hiding and still reject the attention.
