#### **FAQ**

#### Section 4:

Q: Under "other essential elements" the written instructions say that the RRH caseload size is 25, but the online instructions say it is 20. Which is correct?

A: The online instructions are correct. The caseload size for a Rapid Rehousing Housing Stability Case Manager/Housing Navigator is 20.

#### ?: I wanted to verify that the max amount for Supportive Services is \$423,000.00?

A: The maximum available for all Bonus projects is \$425,332. Of that, we most likely lose chances of successful funding if we ask for much more than \$85K in services.

If you want to try for reallocation, for PSH, we are currently spending \$423K on support services across all of the existing PSH projects- so that includes scattered site and project based. Currently those support services dollars are being split across 5 projects which have subcontracts with 7 different agencies.

### ? How may Supportive Service awards are expected to be granted?

A: It will depend on the number of applications submitted, how well they score, and how much funding they request by project type.

#### ? Where do I attach the Race Equity Survey

You will not need to attach. This year we are only asking if you have completed it. We believe that organizations may answer more honestly if they do not have to share their answers this year.

## ? Can we apply to use these funds to purchase property?

A: No, the CoC has again determined that funding this year cannot be used for acquisition, rehab or construction.

? I have marked a section complete, but believe I have answered a question incorrectly and would like to edit. Can you unlock that section?

A: When you go to the top of a section, to the right side you will notice three dots - if you click on those dots there will be a drop down menu that includes an edit button. You can select that and it will open the section back up for you to make changes.

On the other hand- if you submit the entire application you can't reopen and you'd have to start over - so avoid doing that until you've reviewed everything!!
