# The Sealing and Expungement Expansion Project at CLSMF

## History and Overview

In light of 2020 events that brought awareness to all with respect to Civil Rights, CLSMF evaluated the Civil Rights assistance it provided to its Central Florida service area.

- While finding that several of our units provided some form of assistance in Sealing and Expungement, there was room to expand on the assistance provided.
- CLSMF has now consolidated its Sealing and Expungement Services into the Sealing and Expungement Expansion Project.
- In coordination with the CLSMF HELPLine, the Siemens/Siemens Energy Sealing & Expungement Pro Bono Project, and the CLSMF Public Benefits Unit, CLSMF will be able to:
  - ❖ screen customers for eligibility,
  - ❖ assist eligible customers with obtaining a Certificate of Eligibility, and
  - ❖ assist clients with filing and the Petition for sealing or expungement.



# Why should a person apply to seal or expunge a criminal record?

By sealing or expunging a record, a client can greatly increase their ability to gain employment. If the record is sealed or expunged the client can deny or withhold knowledge of a prior arrest from most prospective employers.

Exceptions include but are not limited to

- Applying for a job with law enforcement
- Applying for a job with most governmental agencies
- Applying for admission to the Florida Bar

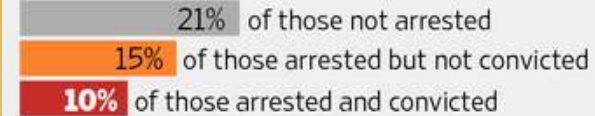
The policy of public access to old records must be weighed against the long-standing public policy of providing a second chance to criminal defendants who have not been adjudicated guilty.

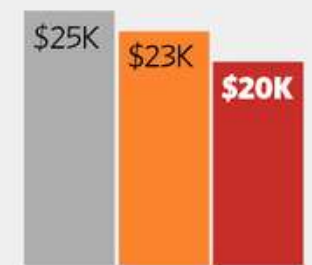
## Impact | What happens after arrest

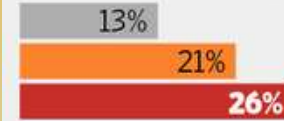
### Own a home at age 25



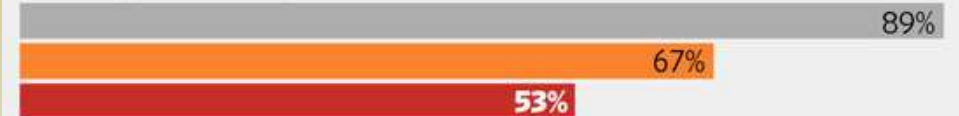
### Median income at age 25



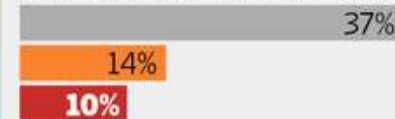
### Household income below poverty line at age 25

# Siemens & Siemens Energy Sealing & Expungement Pro Bono Project

## Clinic Overview

- Attendees will have the opportunity to meet with attorneys individually.
- Attorneys will be able to advise on whether the person seeking assistance is eligible to seal or expunge their record.
- If eligible, attendees will obtain the assistance in completion of the application for a Certificate of Eligibility.
- Attendees will either continue with the pro bono attorney or be transferred to a CLSMF attorney to assess for appeal on denials of the Certificate or to assist with a Petition for sealing or expungement before a judge in the county where the matter is located.

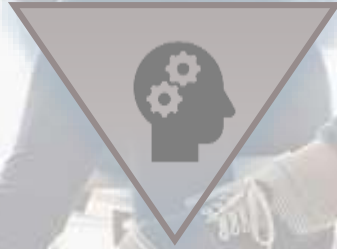

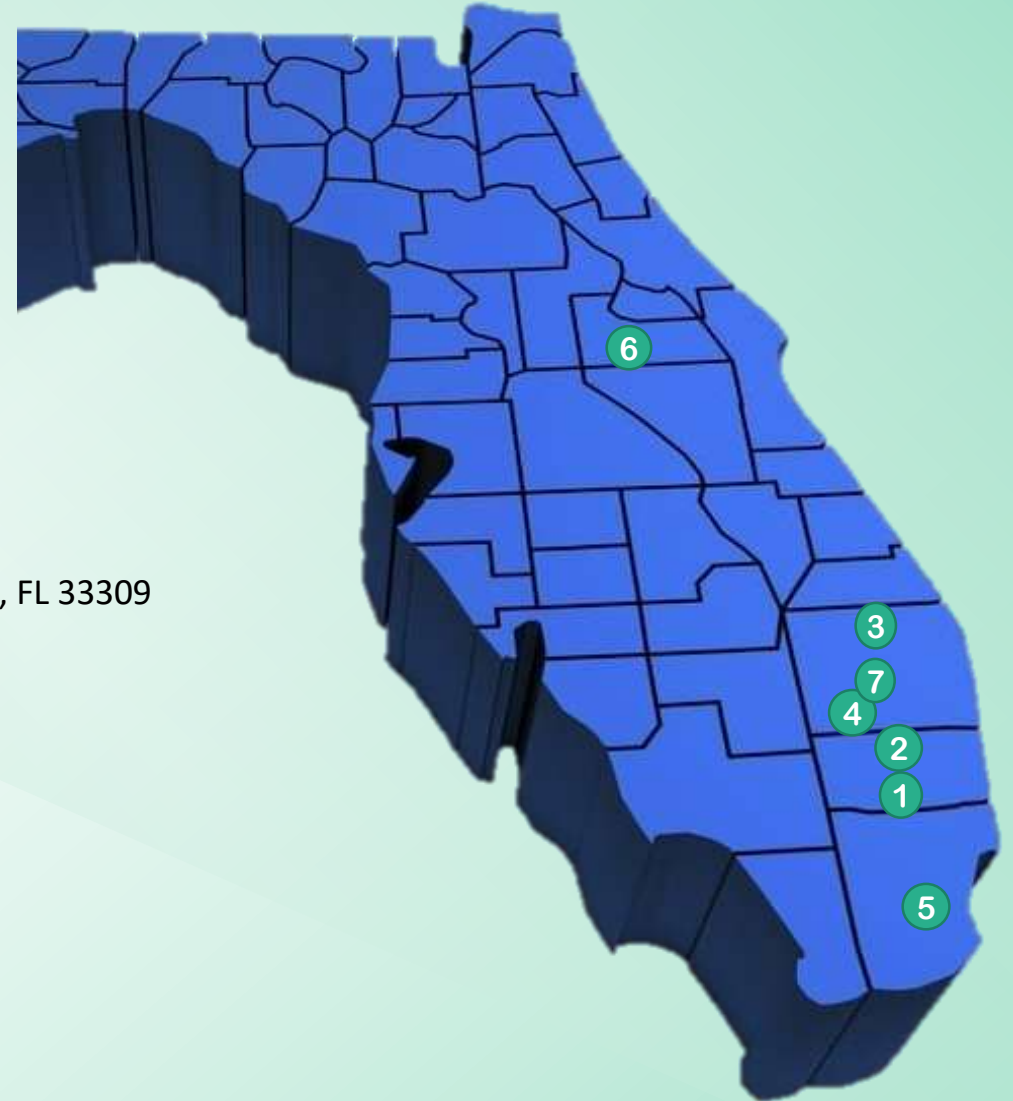

# STD Rates In Florida

Orlando, Gainesville, and Jacksonville are among the top 100 list of U.S. cities for sexually transmitted diseases.

The study was conducted using statistics from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention for the year 2020.

Orlando came in at No. 64 with 932 STD cases reported per 100,000. There were 507 cases of HIV reported.

The findings concluded that STD rates continue to rise in the South, with nearly half of the top 25 cities with the highest STD rates in the South.



# Tasas De ETS En Florida

Orlando, Gainesville y Jacksonville se encuentran entre las 100 principales ciudades de EE. UU. Con enfermedades de transmisión sexual.

El estudio se realizó utilizando estadísticas de los Centros para el Control y la Prevención de Enfermedades para el año 2020.

Orlando ocupó el puesto 64 con 932 casos de ETS reportados por cada 100,000. Se notificaron 507 casos de VIH.

Los hallazgos concluyeron que las tasas de ETS continúan aumentando en el sur, con casi la mitad de las 25 ciudades principales con las tasas de ETS más altas en el sur.



# What Are STDs?

STDs are infections that are spread from one person to another, usually during vaginal, anal, and oral sex. They're really common, and lots of people who have them don't have any symptoms. Without treatment, STDs can lead to serious health problems. But the good news is that getting tested is no big deal, and most STDs are easy to treat.

Las ETS son infecciones que se transmiten de una persona a otra, generalmente durante el sexo vaginal, anal y oral. Son muy comunes y muchas personas que los padecen no presentan ningún síntoma. Sin tratamiento, las ETS pueden provocar problemas de salud graves. Pero la buena noticia es que hacerse la prueba no es gran cosa y la mayoría de las ETS son fáciles de tratar.

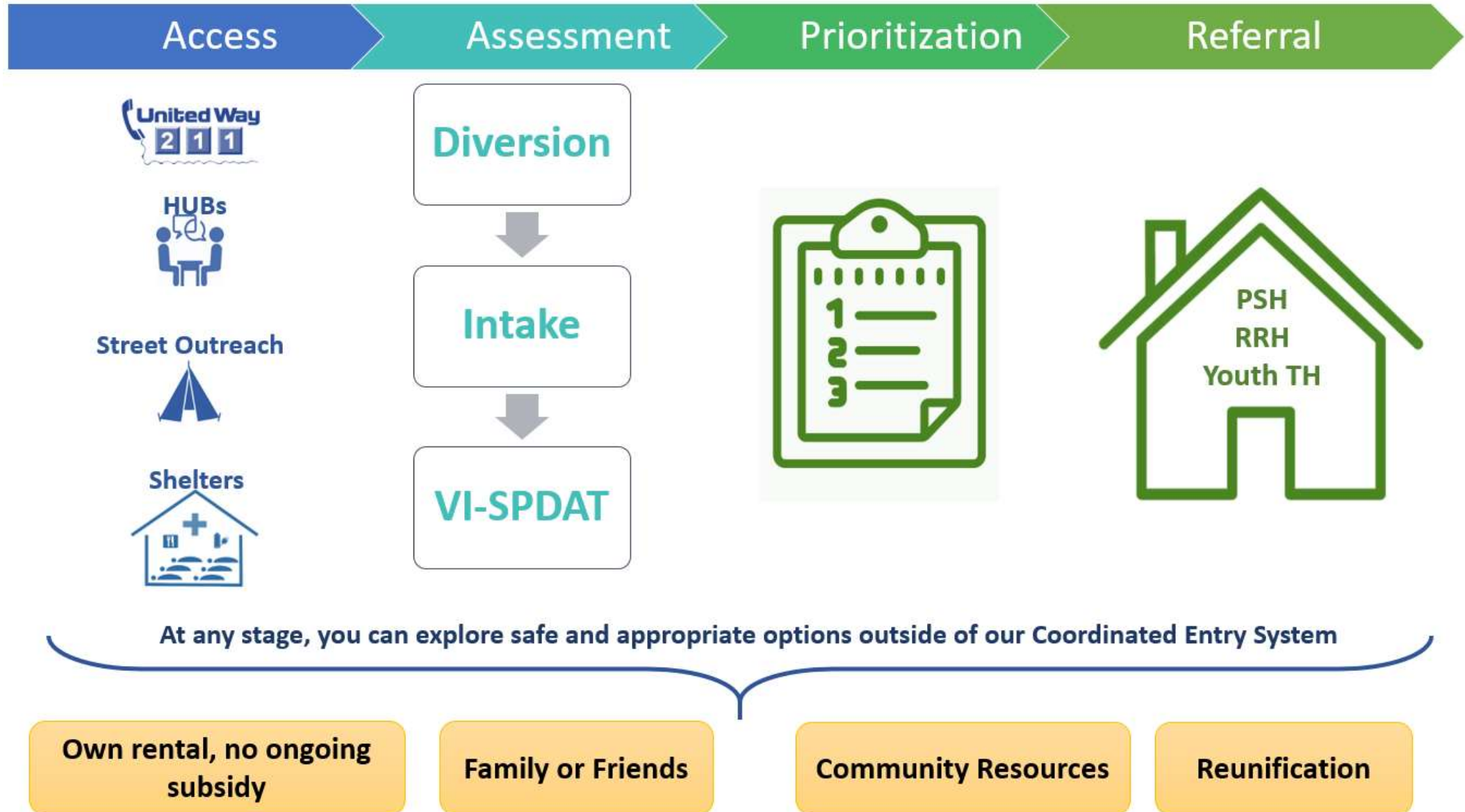

# Access Team Objectives

1. Provide access to resources for those experiencing homeless within our Continuum of Care, which serves Orange, Osceola, and Seminole Counties, regardless of the population type or family composition. Access comes in a variety of ways- in person HUB sites, call in, text, email, or visiting a partner agency.
2. Ensure all those experiencing homelessness receive the same standard approach to resolving their homelessness; while using best practices such as trauma informed care, strengths based conversations, motivational interviewing, and a person centered approach.
3. Provide a safe place for those experiencing a housing crisis to discuss creative housing options. These housing options will always honor safety.
